This trial is open to all dogs TWELVE (12) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), an AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate

No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Entry fees will be deposited after the close date. Trial Secretary will add a \$25 collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST TITLE

If a dog passes the ATT on two occasions, under two different judges, the owner may apply for the AKC Temperament Test (ATT) suffix title by going online to www.akc.org/akctemptest and submitting the ATT title application along with the Evaluator Score Sheets (one from each of the two required tests) and the required title application fee. Upon verification, the ATT title will be applied to the dog's record and will appear on the dog's AKC title record. The title certificate will be mailed to the dog's primary owner of record.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST BASICS

Breed Temperament Information: One purpose of the ATT is to educate dog owners about the temperament of their breeds. At each test, in addition to a title application form and their contact information on the test checklist, handlers must complete the form labeled, "YOUR BREED'S TEMPERAMENT." The form includes a space for the handlers of mixed breed dogs to write about the temperament of their individual dogs. AKC Resources (see below) are the source required for breed specific temperament characteristics for owners. Owners must complete the YOUR BREED form noted. Blank forms may be downloaded from AKC resources (suggested) or may be obtained at the test site on the day of the test.

AKC TEMPERAMENT TEST STATIONS (& EQUIPMENT)

- SOCIAL – Computer bag, backpack, chair in bag on arm, large purse, etc.
- AUDITORY – Large plastic bottle (1-gallon milk jug) w/coins, handheld vacuum cleaner, whistle, bike horn
- VISUAL – Umbrella, Roller bag, wagon, crate dolly or cooler on wheels, towel shake, streamer twirls
- TACTILE – Wire grate (ex-pen), plastic tarp, plastic lattice & memory foam, peg board & air mattress
- PROPRIOCEPTIVE (motion) – PVC ladder/low bars/hurdles, hoops (8), low teeter, low platform
- UNEXPECTED STIMULUS – Large box, large stuffed animal/doll, folding/collapsible chair in bag, walker, wheelchair/crutches, selection of unusual clothing

ADDITIONAL RULES & REGULATIONS

Repeating a Test Item: Dogs may not repeat test items in these categories: Social, Auditory, Visual and Unexpected Stimulus. Dogs may attempt test items a total of 3 times for the Tactile and Proprioceptive categories. Scores are adjusted accordingly when test items are repeated.

Spectator/Crating Space: No spectator space or crating space is available due to limited room space.

Dogs in Building: Limited to dog testing and 2 dogs in the seating/bench area waiting to test.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs--disposal behind the trial building.

Collars: Dogs may wear Slip Collars (on dead ring), Martingales, or Body Harnesses. Dogs may not wear prong collars, e-collars, head collars, or harnesses that restrict the dog's movement.

FLEXI-LEADS are NOT ALLOWED anywhere on the property.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

COVID GUIDELINES: All participants will be required to follow AKC, CDC, and AAKA, Inc. Covid Guideline in place at time of trial; and sign the AAKA, Inc. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely. **It is expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Altoona Area Kennel Association, Inc. and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. The Altoona Area Kennel Association, Inc. reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Altoona Area Kennel Association, Inc. or any official thereof.

REFUNDS:

- *No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- *No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.
- *No entry fee will be refunded for Bitches in season as the ATT allows for this. HOWEVER, owners are 100% responsible for their Bitch and should realize that additional AKC EVENTS are taking place on the property, in the same hall, at the time of these tests. NO DISRUPTION of any AKC event will be tolerated or allowed, potentially resulting in immediate expulsion from the site, WITHOUT REFUND
- *A refund of entries minus \$10 per trial will be granted for injured/incapacitated dogs when a veterinarian's letter is presented as proof to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of the 1st trial day dog was entered. Must use official Veterinary's Letter Head.
- *A refund of entries minus \$2 per trial will be granted for Covid positive handlers or handlers in contact with a positive case within 10 days of trial who cannot attend trial and request a refund prior to the start of the 1st trial day dog was entered.

TESTING TIME AND CHECK-IN TIME: Since approximately 6 dogs can be tested in an hour, your check in time and testing time will be assigned according to when entries arrive or are received by the trial secretary, with allowance made for owner with multiple dogs to test and worker dogs. You will be notified by the secretary of your testing/check in time after the trial closes. All times after the first dog will be "approximate".

Handlers MUST check-in the day they are scheduled to test.

This club does not accept arbitration as set forth on the Official AKC entry Form for this event.

"Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations." As this is a working pet facility, it is highly recommended that dogs are vaccinated for Bordatella within the past 6 months. Proof of Rabies vaccination must be available on request.
